Sewer maintenance in Wassenaarseweg and Oostduinlaan



Starts Saturday 24 June

What: Sewer maintenance
Where: Wassenaarseweg and Oostduinlaan
When: 24 July - end of August 2017

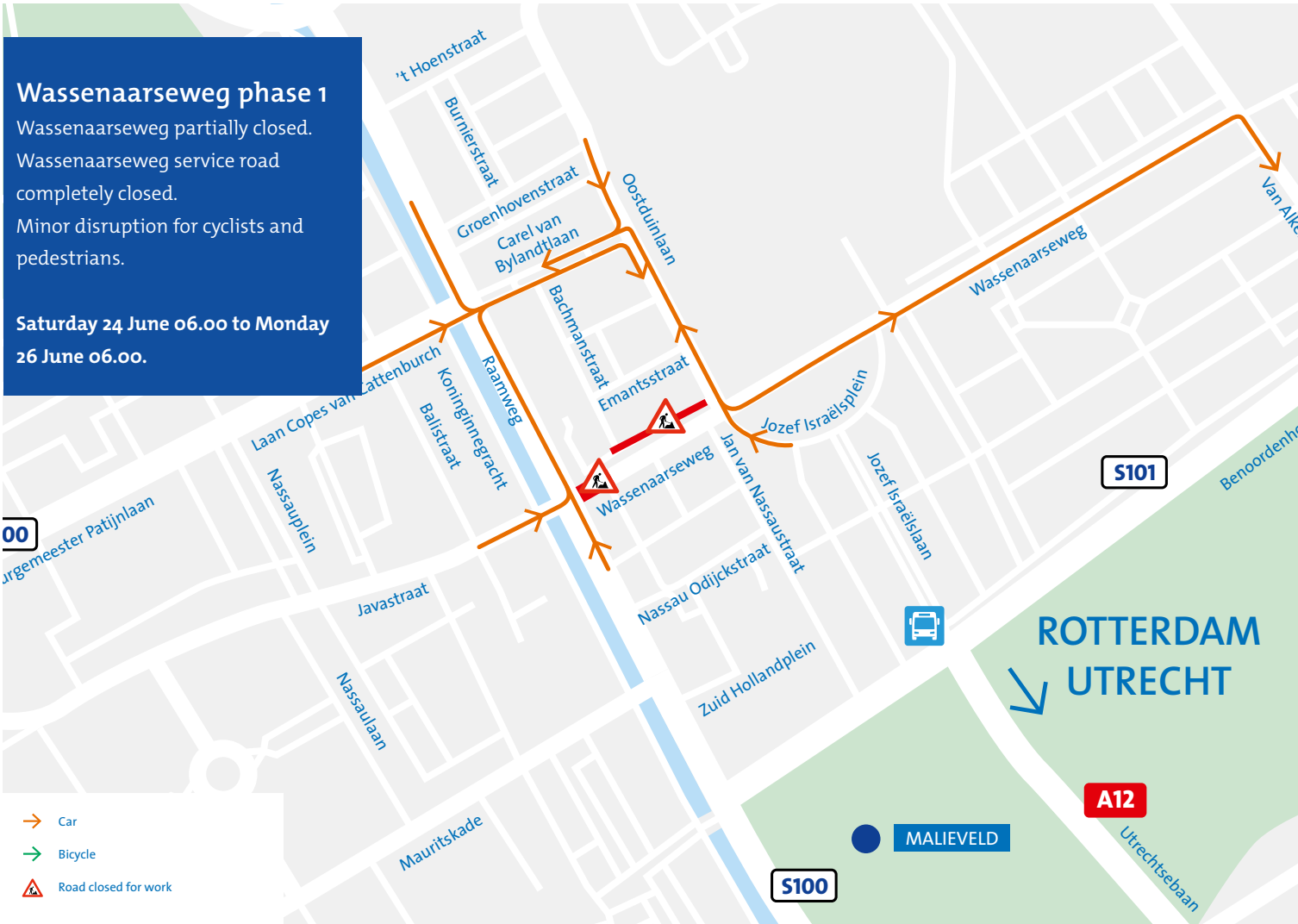
Between Saturday 24 June and the end of August, the Municipality of The Hague will be carrying out sewer maintenance on Wassenaarweg and Oostduinlaan. Both roads will be fully or partially closed at various times. The work is likely to cause disruption.

The work on Wassenaarseweg-Oostduinlaan is the second part of the maintenance work being carried out on Raamweg-Koningskade. Since the end of March, the Municipality has been renovating the sewer in this area. From 24 June, work on the main thoroughfare will have been completed and the maintenance work in the neighbourhood will start. This means that most of the traffic disruption in the city will be over. However, there is still likely to be significant disruption in the neighbourhood, especially in the area immediately around the work.

Wassenaarseweg phase 1

Wassenaarseweg partially closed.
Wassenaarseweg service road completely closed.
Minor disruption for cyclists and pedestrians.

Saturday 24 June 06.00 to Monday 26 June 06.00.



Wassenaarseweg phase 3

Wassenaarseweg mostly closed between Raamweg and Neuhuyskade.
Junction with Oostduinlaan closed.

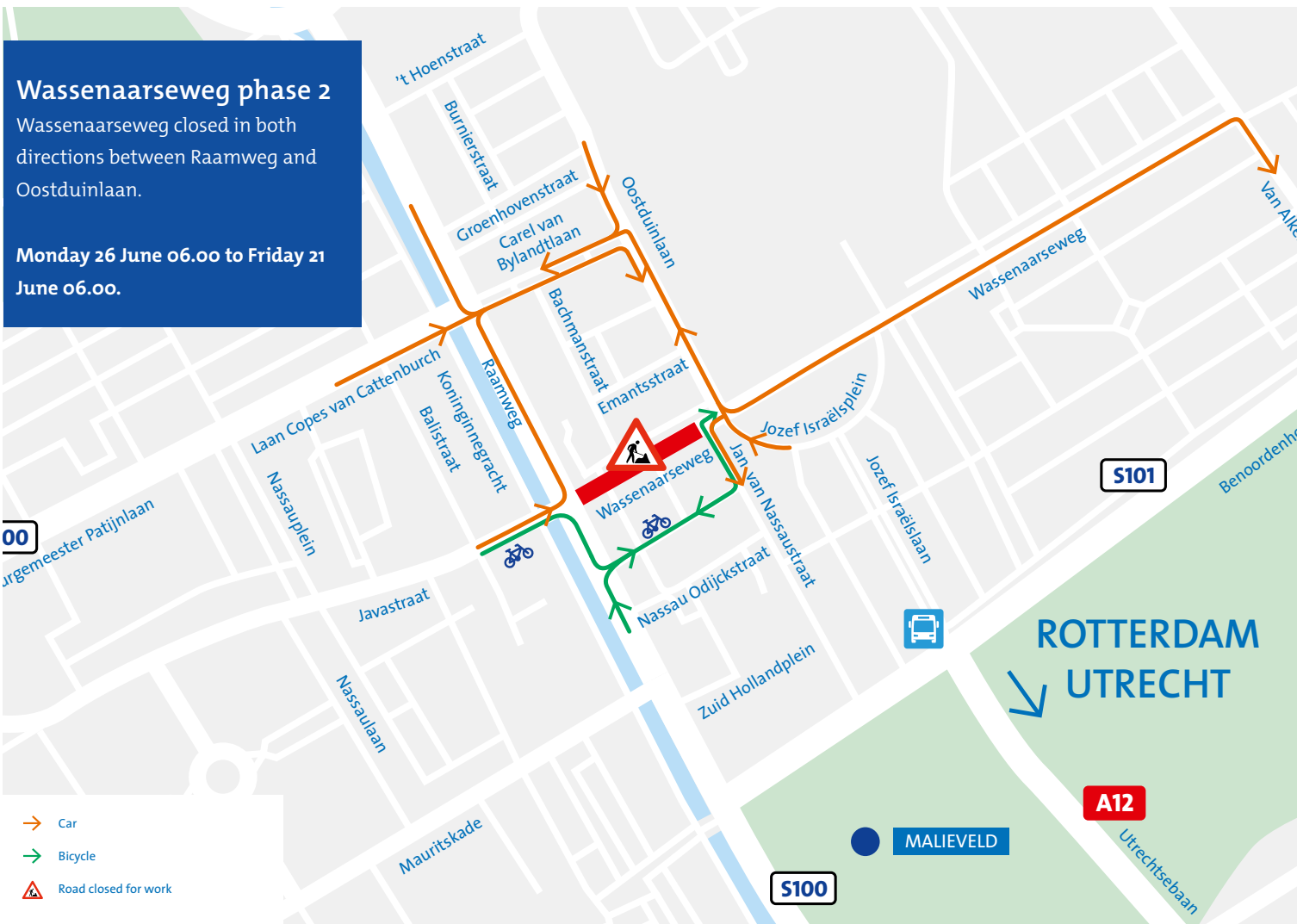
Friday 21 July 06.00 to end of August.



Wassenaarseweg phase 2

Wassenaarseweg closed in both directions between Raamweg and Oostduinlaan.

Monday 26 June 06.00 to Friday 21 June 06.00.



Oostduinlaan

Wassenaarseweg mostly closed between Raamweg and Neuhuyskade. Oostduinlaan closed from Carel van Bylandtlaan to Wassenaarseweg.

Monday 31 July 06.00 to 4 August 18.00. Work may also need to continue from Monday 7 August 06.00 to 11 August 18.00.





What work is being done?

The sewerage system under Wassenaarseweg is old and in need of replacement. For this reason, The Hague is updating the sewerage system under Wassenaarseweg and Oostduinlaan. We are also replacing the asphalt on Wassenaarseweg.

Where will the work be?

Starting on Saturday 24 June, Wassenaarseweg will be closed at the junction with Raamweg. From then on, we will be closing Wassenaarseweg and Oostduinlaan in phases. All road closures are shown on the maps at the centre of this factsheet.

Wassenaarseweg service road

The Wassenaarseweg service road will be inaccessible to vehicles throughout this period. Access to homes and businesses will remain possible by foot. You may have to make use of temporary footpaths. Park elsewhere

When the work starts, parking within the work area will not be possible. We would like to ask you to park your car elsewhere in the neighbourhood.

Accessibility and safety

You will still be able to access your home by foot. You may have to make use of temporary footpaths to reach your home or business. The construction site will be fenced off. Although the Municipality will make every effort to guarantee safety during the work, construction sites remain dangerous places. We advise you to warn children about this.

Household waste

The areas normally used for household waste collections will be inaccessible because of the work. There will be temporary locations where you can dispose of your household waste. These will be clearly signposted.

Noise nuisance

During the work, you will inevitably experience some noise nuisance, caused by heavy equipment or demolition work, for example. There will also be trucks at the construction site. We offer our apologies for this inconvenience. We will of course

make every effort to keep it to a minimum. We will do this by carefully scheduling the delivery and removal of materials to minimise the number of trucks needed. However, since there will be various shifts at work from early in the morning until late in the evening, it will not always be possible to prevent disruption. Changes to bus routes

Until the end of August, the HTM buses 18 and 22 will take an alternative route. Some bus stops will be temporarily out of use.

- From Clingendael, bus 18 in the direction of De Schilp will go via Wassenaarseweg, Van Alkemadelaan, Benoordenhoutseweg and Zuid-Hollandlaan before resuming its normal route. In the opposite direction, bus 18 will take its normal route.
- Bus 22 will be diverted in both directions. From Duinzigt, the bus will go via Oostduinlaan, Groenhovenstraat, Raamweg and Koningskade before resuming its normal route. From the Koningstunnel, the bus will go via Koningskade, Raamweg, Carel van Bylandtlaan and Oostduinlaan before resuming its normal route.

Double shifts

In order to keep road closures to a minimum, we will be working in double shifts, from Monday to Friday between 06.00 and 22.00. The weekends will be kept free as a buffer in order to make up for any setbacks.
